Certified sterile - wheat x wheatgrass cross

Plant description: Triticum aestivum x Elymus trachycaulus 10,000 - 12,000 seeds per lb

Application rates: Nurse Crop - 10lbs/acre or Erosion Control - 30-45lbs/acre Consult your local dealer as sites, seeding rates and planting techniques vary depending on planting objectives and other local factors such as the associated longer-term perennial seed specifications.

Applications: Erodible hillsides, forest fires, rangeland fires, roadsides, landfills, waterways, ski areas, logging sites, mining sites, pipelines, construction areas, wind farms and wetlands.

The best option for: Nurse or cover crop, the only true sterile cross, won't reseed itself and compete with desired species, quick germinating, rapid growth with fibrous root system, perfect for stabilizing soil, winter hardy and drought tolerant.
